On Sept. 24, 2012 the dean of the UF College of Dentistry announced administrative changes for the Department of Orthodontics and

All of our residents continue to successfully pass the American Board of Orthodontics (ABO) exam. With the creation of the School of Advanced Dental Sciences our residents have interdisciplinary core classes and case presentations with residents from other specialties (prosthodontics, periodontology, pediatrics and endodontics). As a result we are treating many more interdisciplinary cases.

We have a nationally and internationally recognized faculty who continue to publish their outstanding research.

In March 2012 we hired Dr. Wellington Rody as a full time assistant professor. He is married and has a young daughter. He is a Brazilian trained orthodontist with many years of experience. 


ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

VOLUNTEER FACULTY SPOTLIGHT

Dr. Page Jacobson became the first part-time faculty member in the newly-formed UF Department of Orthodontics in 1976. Page served in the U.S. Navy and continued in the naval reserve until retiring as a captain from the Navy Dental Corps in 1984 after serving for 21 years. He graduated from Emory Dental School and the Washington University Orthodontic Program and then moved to Gainesville, Fla., to establish a private practice. He has, literally, taught every orthodontist who has graduated from our program. The first class graduated in 1978 and the graduates were Dr. Steve Chapman (Palatka) and the late Dr. Steve Paige (Ocala). Today we have graduated 99 orthodontists.

He is well respected in the dental community, having served in numerous leadership roles in organized orthodontics at the local, state and national level.
