# INFANT ORAL HEALTH CLINIC

## ELECTIVE PROPOSAL

**Commencement** : Fall of the Junior Year ( Sept) - after finishing the 7826 rotation

**Completion** : Spring of Senior Year ( before graduation)

**Total time** : 6 hours ( = 1 credit point)

**Aiming** : Community/Outreach Projects - small groups

### **Methodology/Activity planned:**

*First Encounter* : 2 hours

- Initial Training containing all the basic information in the Infant Oral Health Practices
- Project Description : each student will be allocated a specific project / designated community / target population/ area

*Second Encounter* : 30 minutes

- Project follow-up /feedback
- individual meetings and discussions

*Remaining Time* : 2.5 hours

- Field time/work
- Preparation for project presentation
- Other classes and group of students/staff can be invited for the presentations.

# INFANT ORAL HEALTH CLINIC

## ELECTIVE PROPOSAL

### OUTLINE

The goal is to expose the undergraduate dental students to the infant population ( 0 to 3 years old) and pregnant teenagers, using a risk-based disease approach to establish an early prevention and intervention course of care. The participating students will use every point of intervention to engage and educate parents and caregivers , making sure the child has access to a reliable preventive and restorative care , connected to dental home .

### METHODOLOGY/ACTIVITY PLANNED

The students will receive a basic training/lecture on the Infant Oral Health /Dentistry for the Infants, learning how to follow the patient's first assessment, involving the medical and dental history, the caries risk and all the educational protocol for the parents and caregivers .The assessment will give to the students a baseline for treatment plan and follow ups, based on the risk assessment and caries activity. It will expose the students to the concept that a disease management and prevention model can reduce disease and improve outcomes.

Different community sites will be used, such as church groups, day care centers as part of the outreach projects. The caries risk assessment can also be performed on the Mothers as well on the Infants- to analyze vertical transmission, habits, diet and the other co-related factors.

The teenager pregnancy can also be a target population to be assessed and educated ; both groups – pregnant teens and Infants - fall under the umbrella of the IOHC.

## **EVALUATION MECHANISM/ CRITERIA**

The students will be evaluate by their projects

- beginning, mid-term and end/presentation.

The outreach work will be evaluated

- per visit/activity that recorded on an EXCELL spread sheet.

The caries risk assessment

- CAMBRA – will be the form used
