New Proposals	<p>Dr. Katkar – Request to extend DEN 7762 to through semester 11</p> <p>Dr. Shen – Biomaterial Proposal: DEN 7717 removal of amalgam and resequence DEN 8719 from semester 10 to 9</p>	<p>The committee was not in support of having one class extend from semester 6-11. Students would have no radiology grade feedback until graduation.</p> <p>The committee did not fully understand the removal of amalgam from the DEN 7717 biomaterials manipulation list without communicated support and further curriculum alignment from the Department of Restorative Sciences.</p>	<p>Motion: The committee recommended Dr. Katkar consider establishing a senior clinical radiology course DEN 8765L- Clinical Radiology: Radiographic Technique and Interpretation. Approved.</p> <p>Motion: The committee approved moving the dental biomaterials board review portion of DEN 8719 from semester 10 to semester 9. Dr. Shen is advised to get department support for removal of amalgam in DEN 7717. (Culp/ Cooper) - Approved</p>	
Student Recommendations	More Time in Endo Labs	<p>Ms. Isaacs reported the new split time in endo labs works fine for psychomotors but not as well for regular lab sessions. The length of time between labs is very long and not as productive, and recommended having weekly classes for practice.</p> <p>Mrs. Childs noted previous debriefing recommendations included split labs each week.</p>	Motion: The Department of Endodontics is asked to consider weekly labs of two class groups on the same half day (e.g. 12:30-2:45 and 2:45-5:00). (Childs / Culp) Approved	
Old Business	Dept. of Endodontics, Curriculum Committee and SPEC for review of "I" and "E" grades	Dr. Sposetti summarized the meeting with the Department of Endodontics, SPEC students and Curriculum Committee Vice Chair. It was recognized that the termination of the Choices program and the clinical transition of increased indirect pulp capping have reduced endodontic patient availability.	Outcome summary, Dr. U. Nair will: 1) send more information about the Endo list process to students, 2) request students that receive personal emails from her reply back directly to her and 3) develop	

			supportive care guidelines for pulp capping. The endodontic department will also report emergency visits following pulp capping treatment to Dr. Stewart.

The goal of this process is to be able to track students with repeated professional variances.</p>
