<b>Updates</b>	Dean's Charge to the Committee  Curriculum Revision Faculty Forums	<p>The Dean's Office Expects to have the Committee Charges distributed next week.</p> <p>Dr. Culp reported the faculty forums have had few attendees and another was scheduled for Monday, Sept. 9, at 8am.
