Curriculum Management	DEN 6213C, Debriefing Summary DEN 6001, Debriefing Summary Semester 3 Debriefing Summary Update on Endo/Pros Integration	G. Childs reviewed the DEN 6213C Debriefing Summary. For the articulator lecture Dr. El-Kerdani suggested using 3D articulator software. G. Childs reviewed the DEN 6001 Debriefing Summary. Dr. Culp suggested using evidence-based in several courses and not just in DEN 6001. G. Childs reviewed the Semester 3 Debriefing Summary. Dr. El-Kerdani reported 2 post and core presentations are being integrated in the Spring DEN6415C course. One presentation is from Operative Dentistry. Dr. Ottenga will lecture about pre-fabricated posts and include a lab exercise. The other presentation is from Endodontics. 	Request to change clinical endodontic assigned case points. Sequencing and Sustainability of Small Group Case-based Learning	Dr. U. Nair proposed a change in the endodontic clinical curriculum starting with the class of 2016. The change is to address the possibility of students to graduate with the current points system by only working on anterior teeth. The proposal to the current system would require students to do either a 2 canal premolar or molar as part of their formative assessments.	Dr. U.
