Sharepoint Overview	Paul Benton demonstrated how to approve minutes in Sharepoint through multiple browsers and is available to users that have any difficulties.	Information Item.
Request the resequencing of DEN 8321, Dental Practice Management	Curricular (Rotations, Clinical Examination II) and extracurricular (Interviews, National & State Board exam changes) have placed increasing demands for student time away in Semester 10. Dr. Minden requested this course be moved from Semester 10 to Late Semester 10/Semester 11. Censeri has confirmed this scheduling could be accommodated. 4DN DMD Graduate Perio rotation proposal	Dr. Harrison proposed several changes to the 3DN & 4DN Graduate Perio rotations approved last year. Specifically, the department is requesting to change from two rotations (each 6 half-days) with 4 students (54 hours) to one rotation (8 half-days) with 3 students per week (32 hours). Reasons for this change include a reduced number of surgical patients in Graduate Periodontics , feedback from students and primarily, the revised clinical hour changes.
