Guests	Update on curricular DMD additions in the new HRSA proposal	<p>Dr. Catalanotto reported the current HRSA grant expires June 30, 2015. The new HRSA grant has a financial cap limit. One of the three projects being supported by the new HRSA grant is a summer experience program (STARS). It places students the summer before dental school in community based settings incorporated with an IPE experience.</p> <p>The second project would extend the second-year public health rotation into the first year. Students go to WIC and HeadStart where they would provide screening, risk assessment and fluoride application with parental consent..</p> <p>The third project involves modifications in DEN 5221 to involve more community based experiences.</p>	The second project requires a proposal brought before the Curriculum Committee. This will be done at a later meeting.

If two or more disciplines are not passed in the first week, they can be carried into the second week of remediation.
