Proposal	Request to Increase Extramural Rotations from 6 weeks to 8 weeks	<p>Dr. Gibbs joined the meeting via conference call. UFCD expanded from 4 to 6 weeks of extramural rotation in 2011. Approximately 22% of clinical productivity is currently completed on extramural rotations in the senior year. The current proposed expansion is to increase from 2 to 3 weeks in the Fall and Spring semester of the senior year by adding one week to the existing 2 weeks in a semester. Summer rotations will stay 2 weeks.</p> <p>Dr. Culp asked if student assessment would change as a result of these additional two weeks of rotation. Students will receive credit for RVU's when off-site. However, some disciplines have capped how many credits can be achieved towards class requirements such as Operative. The students will experience a more clinical, business setting that has a dedicated assistant where they can continue to develop their skills.</p> <p>One reason for this change is the increased number of students in the Class of 2017 and the school's limited number of clinical chairs. Dr. Stewart explained that all competency assessment will still be completed in the TEAM program (endodontic patient care will be the exception) and that management of comp care patients will be assigned to a junior and senior team. Dr. El-Kerdani expressed concern of the students having difficulty completing graduation requirements.</p>	<p>Dr. Gibbs will revise the syllabi and send to the committee for final review and vote.</p> <p>UPDATE: Syllabi were sent and the motion to increase from 2 to 3 week rotations in Semester 10 and 11 were approved via email.</p>
