Predicting Pain Outcomes of Root Canal Treatment

A study on determining the predictive factors related to experiencing severe post-operative pain following initial orthograde root canal treatment, as well as the economic impact that both acute and persistence of pain has on the patient experiencing it, is being developed by the National Dental PRRN. The Network hopes the outcomes of this research will inform the decision-making process that the dentists have with their patients related to individualizing the care provided.

This will be a prospective observational study with 1-year follow up of patients receiving root canal treatment. No alterations to usual endodontic care will be required.
