Operative Dentistry	Student Assessment Course Review	<p>Dr. D. Dilbone provided an overview of student assessment in the Operative Dentistry courses. The number of clinical expectations has been reduced. Competencies are all pass/fail and graded on a scale of 1-4. There was some committee discussion on competency assessment being pass/fail based on critical errors rather than on a set number of remediable skills. See handouts.</p> <p>How professionalism is graded in student daily assessments and competency assessments was raised in addition to dental biomaterials assessment. A meeting to discuss this with Clinical Course Directors was suggested.</p>	<p>The OOE will set up a meeting with Clinical Course Directors and Department Chairs to discuss removal of grades in competency assessments and to review the professionalism rubric in the TEAM program and Pediatric Dentistry with Steve Kostewicz to answer reporting questions.</p> <p>Dr. Dilbone to send the student assessment forms for DEN5320C, DEN6502C and DEN8321.</p> <p>G. 	<p>Pharmacotherapeutics and DEN 6262, Principles of Pharmacology</p> <p>Clinical Innovations Workgroup Update/Pairing 3DN/4DN students in TEAM program</p> <p>Review of ECO and Canvas functionality</p>	<p>indicated the current Spring sequencing of DEN 6260 and DEN 6262 should remain.</p> <p>Dr. D. Dilbone summarized the pairing of juniors and seniors to enhance clinical learning through shared patients and peer learning. See handout. RVUs will be earned by both senior and junior students for completed procedures, and juniors who assist can earn assisting credit in Periodontics and Operative Dentistry. In Prosthodontics, when the student pair completes, mentors, assists, both will receive the same RVUs and both can earn units following the "Units Policy." Students cannot earn more than 40% of the required RVUs from assisting and/or mentoring in any discipline. Skills assessments / competency examinations are completed independently. They are not completed as a pair.</p> <p>G. Childs referred to the handout for the comparison of ECO and Canvas features. Examssoft is projected to integrate with Canvas at the end of summer semester. See handout. Currently there is not availability of courses for students to reference documents and videos across the 4 years in Canvas. Course Directors are advised to keep their syllabi, gradebooks and documents in ECO and use canvas for online tools and student submissions to avoid duplication.</p>	<p>6260 and Dr. M.
