Childs reported that these courses have softly migrated earlier for the past two years in relation to changes in the scheduling timeframes to take NDBE Part 2 as early as August. DEN8263:Advanced Oral Medicine and Clinical Pharmacology has an online component to review materials for NDBE Part 2 and a small group case-based section following the midterm. DEN8303: Advanced Radiologic Interpretation is an online course also with NDBE Part 2 review materials. Beginning these classes in Spring semester will ensure student materials are distributed and reviewed prior to students challenging NDBE Part 2.</p> <p>DEN 5120C: Physiology – Dr. Hideko Kasahara will be the new course Director beginning Fall 2017. <p>Curriculum Management</p>	<p>Spring 2017 Course Evaluation Summary</p> <p>DEN 5127, Infectious Diseases Debriefing Summary</p>	<p>G. Childs reviewed the overall course evaluation summary data for Spring 2017.</p> <p>Dr. Abranches was the new course director. Recommendation take-aways from the debriefing included, more and earlier clinical correlations and continue to provide practice exam questions beyond Exam 1. Dr. Abranches is supportive of these suggestions. She will continue to make lecture attendance voluntary next year.</p> <p>Mentioned in this course, and in several other course debriefings over the past several years, is student difficulty in interpreting style and syntax of multiple choice questions written by faculty where English is a second language.</p>	<p>Course debriefings have been scheduled for new Course Directors and courses scoring 3.0 or below.</p>
<p>Workgroup Updates</p>	<p>Earlier Clinical Experiences</p> <p>Global Assessment</p> <p>Evaluation of TEAM Program</p>	<p>Dr. Dilbone reported that this workgroup met several weeks ago and another meeting is scheduled next week.</p> <p>Dr. Sposetti and G. Childs have been reviewing all of the new competency statements and condensing the number of competency assessments for each competency statement. This will be reviewed by the workgroup at their next meeting.</p> <p>Dr. Dilbone reported this workgroup met last week yet there were no students in attendance and this is strongly encouraged.</p>	
<p>Information Item</p>	<p>UF Accessibility Committee</p>	<p>Dr. Sposetti reported that UF is launching a diversity-based access Strategic Plan. Up until now accommodations has been on an individual basis. This is now transitioning to a civil rights issue with an expectation of native accessibility for all students. There have been recent hefty lawsuits with audits by the Office of Civil Rights and/or 5 year, rather intrusive, inspection plans. UF has a long-term timeframe beginning with November 1, when all new webpages must be compliant. Close captioning and transcription costs were discussed. Students offered these services as part of a TA role.</p>	<p>Dr. Sposetti will be attending a University Committee tomorrow and will share updated information from this meeting.</p>
