<b>Proposals</b>	<p>DEN8710L: Request for one day Santa Fe rotation</p> <p>DEN5210: Request for 3 hours</p> <p>DEN7433L-new assignment</p>	<p>Dr. Hardeman summarized the request for a one-day rotation at Santa Fe College with the 4DN students in Spring, Semester 11 as part of DEN8710L, Community Dentistry 3. Students will work with dental assisting and dental hygiene students similar to private practice. Patients with operative procedures will be scheduled and Operative Dentistry will accept all procedures/rvu's in their student clinical expectation totals. The TEAM 3DN partners will maintain care of the UFCD comprehensive care patients. Dr. Dilbone will calibrate Dr. Zellmer, the supervising faculty member. The rotation will be evaluated at the end of the semester for determination of continuation. Additional goals of this rotation include patient referrals to UFCD for comprehensive patient care and identifying patients that meet the criteria for the Florida licensure exam.</p> <p>G. <b>Curriculum Management</b>	DEN6432C: Debriefing Summary	G. Childs summarized the DEN6432C: Basic Endodontic Therapy debriefing comments. Dr. Pileggi was a new Course Director. Students prioritized including an orientation to the course to outline student expectations, aligning the grading in this course with Clinical Exam I, additional faculty in sim lab, demonstrations (video or live) prior to each lab, an endodontic review session prior to clinical exam I and adding examples of common endodontic errors for beginners. 	DEN5405C: Debriefing Summary	G. Childs summarized the DEN5405C: Preclinical Operative Dentistry/Biomaterials debriefing comments. Dr. Ribeiro was a new Course Director. Students felt Dr. Ribeiro created a positive learning environment with her calming and compassionate demeanor and her dedication in prepping 100 teeth for students with early caries. They spoke highly that she knew everyone's name, she listened and helped them transition failure into a path to improvement. For the next class offering student prioritized re-vising the biomaterials to be clinical relevant, create course materials on common early mistakes and how to correct them and consider moving 4-handed dentistry to Operative 2 in semester 3 when they can apply the practice. <b>Workgroup Updates</b>	Global Assessment	Dr. Hardeman summarized the activities of the global assessment workgroup. To date this workgroup has reviewed all of the UFCOD competency assessments (149) aligned to the new competency statements (26) and have narrowed the global assessments 45. Ideally, this number should be lower to track and report to CODA. The workgroup would like Curriculum Committee review of the process to date. The time to review will take a mini retreat or an extended meeting time. The Office of Education will propose the meeting and arrange for food.
