New Business - HSC Library	Pilot test of Board Vitals Pain Management Workgroup	Sarah Meyer provided a summary of the pilot test with Board Vitals (a self-assessment study aid for the INBDE and other HS Board exams by the same publishers as StatRef). In August, the HSC library conducted a one-week trial with one hour of use by dental students participating. The license cost is \$30,000 annually (compared to the current \$11,000 annually for ExamMaster.) The library is currently undergoing budget cuts so colleges could be asked to cost share this licensure if there is student value. The library will continue to evaluate these and other tools as we move closer to the INBDE. Dr. Hardeman provided an update on the work that Dr. Hardeman and Dr. Sposetti have recently done to address the Florida Surgeon General's request to review Health Sciences Curriculum for prescribers relating to the Opioid epidemic in November. The Office of Education did an audit on the DMD program, including the offsite clinics to gather information for this presentation. There was mutual agreement that this would be the ideal time to establish a workgroup to review pain management and alternatives with recommendations if necessary based on the findings. It was noted we are weak on addiction/substance use disorders. Dr. Caudle and Dr. Widmer volunteered for this committee.	Information Item - Sarah will continue to update the Curriculum Committee on national board study aid resources.
