Examinations 5/22-5/26

After retake examinations were complete, all students passed and started clinical patient care by 6/16 (one exception*)

93 students took the examination

1 Student did not complete the examination*

20 Students failed one or more section (13 students failed a single exam, 6 students failed two exams, 1 student failed 3 exams)

DIDACTIC

5 students failed the Oral Examination

7 students failed the Written Examination

PSYCHOMOTOR

5 students failed the Operative Psychomotor Exam

7 students failed the Fixed Prosthodontics Psychomotor Exam

2 students failed the Endodontics Psychomotor Exam

History

Through 2009 The course was designed to teach students to plan for and successfully complete examinations similar to those encountered in licensure examination.

2010-2017

The course was designed to assess students critical thinking skills in tx planning and readiness for entry into the TEAM clinical patient care group.

2013 Problems

The entire course was given 4 times to 3 students

3 retakes were permitted within each course (4 attempts to pass)

One student was permitted to begin patient care while two others were not

2014 Course was redesigned

Students were required to pass all exams in each section or all had to be retaken. (This required adjustment the following year.)

A very structured remediation was given before the students could attempt a retake. (This was very successful.)

Only one retake was permitted.

An additional procedure was added to the operative psychomotor. (This caused the exam to be too long.)

2015 Course was redesigned for everyone to pass

Limited to no supervision on examinations.

Oral exam contained the same questions from previous years.

Written exam was repeated from previous years.
