| Student Recommendations | Student Assessment in the TEAM program | Adam Tow provided a summary of student grading in the TEAM program. Overall students report there is little mentoring in the daily grading process and calibration of faculty in assigning daily grades creating student frustration. Dr. Dilbone mentioned this was reported in the Student Affairs meeting and was recently discussed and reviewed at the RDS meeting and a DMD clinic meeting. She clarified that all grades are issued according to the rubric and that students are not penalized for asking questions. Best Practices identified included having faculty members ask students how they would rate themselves on the daily grading rubric and agreeing or discussing differences when the grades are swiped. Additionally students are encouraged to report any faculty members that are outliers in this grading process to their TEAM leader. | |
