Outcome Measures	Florida licensure exam results	The committee reviewed the pass/fail sections of the Florida Licensure exam for the Class of 2018. Students that failed portions can retake in June.	There were no recommendations made on these outcomes.
Old Business	Global Competency Assessment of Students	<p>Dr. Perez and Dr. Guelmann reviewed Pediatric Dentistry’s revised competency assessments:</p> <p>DEN7825L: A new Case-based exam was created with 30 questions. Dr. Guelmann and Dr. Perez are flexible in the implementation and scoring of the assessment.</p> <p>DEN7826L: Special Needs –Dr. Burtner has developed teaching materials summarizing most common conditions affecting patients with special needs and 5 Case Scenario competency assessments. There is a need for further discussion of logistics in implementation and passing grade.</p> <p>DEN8828L: Students meet in small group seminars at the end of the rotation week to participate in case-based discussions. At the end of these seminars, students challenge a 5-question assessment (2 of the 5 questions are designated as competency assessments). The remediation assessment is conducted on the spot if these questions are not answered correctly. The remediation exam questions are open-ended and address the same covered topics. Timing for implementation: Fall 2018.</p>	Gail will arrange a follow meeting with Dr. Guelmann and Dr. Perez to discuss scheduling and grading logistics to the newly developed Pediatric Competency assessments.

		Dr. Kompotiati reviewed the Periodontology competency assessments. The Department has transitioned the simple S/RP to a formative assessment. The Department wishes to continue with the existing S/RP Complex, Phase I and Supportive Periodontal Therapy competency assessments.	
New Business		Dr. Sposetti provided an overview of the changing landscape of dental licensure and the development of a new OSCE examination (DLOCSE) in development with deployment in 2020 if accepted by the state boards. (See handout)
