	<p>DEN8710L: Community Dentistry III– Semester 11: Santa Fe Rotation</p> <p>DEN5404C: Dental Anatomy and Stomatognathics</p>	<p>Pilot Evaluation: A Santa Fe rotation debriefing with senior students suggested 2 students rather than 4 be assigned due to patient cancelations. They also suggested considering this rotation in the junior rather than senior year. Students noted that the bur selection was extremely limited.</p> <p>An administrative debriefing with UF and Santa Fe faculty felt 3DN students did not have enough clinical crown preparation experience for a 3DN rotation. They agreed 2 to 3 students per day to maximize this experience. They also requested a streamlined referral process to UFCD. Dr. Zellmer was open to considering some additional bur types.</p> <p>Request: The Santa Fe Rotation-begin 4DN rotation after Fall break with 2 to 3 students and a mandatory orientation at Santa Fe College.
