Proposals	<p>Request to move oral examination from DEN7961: Clinical Examination I to DEN6302C: Introduction to Clinical Diagnosis and Treatment Planning -- in Spring 2019.</p> <p>Review initial draft to resequencing the Professionalism Courses in Stream 3.</p>	<p>This agenda item was tabled at the November 8 meeting until a student survey could be completed. Ninety eight percent of the class supported changing the date of the oral exam in April 2019 semester break. 2DN students will leave 2 days later for break and these dates will be added to the return week so the same number of days are allotted to them as before. The benefit to the students is that they can proceed to clinical entry experiences at the beginning of semester 6. The Course Director has agreed to make accommodations for the students with prior arrangements.</p> <p>Dr. Sposetti presented a draft of the Stream 3 Professionalism Course to reflect one class across each year.
