Who does what at UFCD?

Admissions Office	Program Directors & their Admissions Committee
Receives PASS applications and application materials	Reviews complete applications
Emails applicants regarding status of applications (received, incomplete, complete, etc.)	Selects competitive applicants for interviews
Forwards complete applications to Program Directors and their Admissions Committee for review	Holds interviews
Manages admissions database	Selects competitive interviewees for residency positions

What is **PASS**?

- **PASS** is similar to AADSAS (www.aдея.org)
- Centralized Application
- Saves duplication and time in filling out the basics, uploading personal statements and resumes, coordinating letters of recommendation
- 2020 ADEA **PASS** Application Cycle
May 15, 2019 - February 7, 2020

PASS cost estimate for the 2020 Application Cycle

- \$190 = Base application processing fee
- +\$77 = for each additional program



Examples

2 programs: $\$190 + (1 \times \$77) = \$267$

5 programs: $\$190 + (4 \times \$77) = \$498$

8 programs: $\$190 + (7 \times \$77) = \$729$

PASS: Professional Evaluation Form (PEF)

- PEF is similar to a Letter of Recommendation (LOR)
- Applicants must submit a minimum of 3 PEFs with their PASS application, with the option to submit an additional two PEFs (maximum of 5 PEFs)
- PEFs are no longer customized by program, one set of PEFs will be sent to all programs (all programs receive the same set of PEFs)
- PEF ≠ IEF (Institution Evaluation Form)

PASS Search Engine

- The **PASS** Search Engine has select information for every program in **PASS**

PASS Application is complete* if...

- PASS has received your online application
- Fee payment
- Required documents (varies with program)
 - Curriculum Vitae (CV)/Resume
 - PEFs (at least 3)
 - Institution Evaluation Form (IEF)
 - Official dental school transcript

Complete Application

- Some programs ask for additional information or requirements in addition to what **PASS** requires
- Follow the directions on the **PASS** website and send the additional materials to the school separate from **PASS**
- Please check the program's webpage for detailed information

Complete Application

- All of the Advanced and Graduate Education Programs at UFCD require additional information to be sent to the Office of Admissions
- Additional requirements may include:
 - Undergraduate transcripts (from all institutions attended)
 - Digital photo (professional)
 - NBME CBSE
 - GRE

- Match is an independent service that matches applicants with programs

The National Matching Program

- This program matches residents with programs
- Applicants are matched based on their ranked list of programs and the programs' list of the applicants
- Each applicant is assigned a position in only one program
- The **Match** is binding

The National Matching Program

- Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD)
- General Practice Residency (GPR)
- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMS)
- Orthodontics (ORTHO)
- Pediatric Dentistry (PED)
- Periodontics (PERIO)
- Prosthodontics (PROS)
- Dental Anesthesiology (ANES)

The Match at UFCD

- Orthodontics
- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
 - 4 year
 - 6 year
- Pediatric Dentistry
 - Gainesville
 - Naples
- Periodontics
- Prosthodontics

PASS and Match are linked

- Single-site sign-up process begins in late May
- Applicants for either or both services can enter data on the **PASS** website
- You must apply to both **PASS** and **Match**; you cannot just apply to **Match**
- **Match** results are posted on the **Match** webpage

Match Program Dates: 2 Phases

- Register with **Match** before October 1, 2019
- Phase I – ORTHO, PERIO, PROS, ANES, Canadian GPR
Mid November 2019: Deadline for match lists
Late November 2019: **Match** results released
- Phase II - OMFS, PED, AEGD, US GPR
Mid January 2020: Deadline for match lists
Late January 2020: **Match** results released
- Registration Fee: \$95
