<b>Welcome</b>	Dr. Robert Burne	
<b>Dr. Joseph Riley-</b>  Results of Annual Research Survey	Dr. Riley started the meeting by discussing the results from the annual research survey. Problems discussed included issues with IT support and timeliness, as well as potentially supporting faculty members needing help with writing an IRB.	It may be beneficial to have someone from IT visit the research areas to see if the researchers are receiving the support that they need or use. Information regarding IRB's might be useful presented at the Faculty Assembly.
<b>UF Administrative Memo:</b> Federal Agency Disclosure Requirements for Grant Supported Investigators – Disclosing Financial Support from Foreign Entities.	The memo included information about disclosures regarding foreign entities, and that support or equipment from a foreign country must be disclosed when applying for federal awards. Additionally, prompt disclosure of intellectual property is required of all faculty, staff and students.	
<b>Summer Research Program</b>	Discussed the need for more mentors for the summer research program.	
<b>“Discussion of Research” elective</b>	This course began in January and will run through December, and is designed to inform students about research opportunities at UFCD. It meets on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Tuesday in Jan-May and Sept-Dec. Dr. Burne is the course director and has organized a series of faculty presentations. There are still some slots for faculty who may be interested in presenting their research project(s) to DMD students.	
<b>UF Moonshot</b>	11 proposals have been approved under this initiative. UFCD shared oversight for the development of “Employing Precision Health Modalities to Advance Understanding of Inflammation and Immune Response”. <u>Organizational meetings and pilot funding programs are in the planning phases.</u> Inflammation and disease pilot programs will be formed.
