Proposals	<p>Preparation for Clinical Practice Courses Proposal</p> <p>DEN7961: Clinical Exam 1 Proposal</p> <p>DEN7761L, DEN7766L, DEN8768L: Clinical Treatment Planning Courses Update</p>	<p>Richelle Janiec provided an overview of the draft preparation for clinical practice course proposal.</p> <p>Dr. Dilbone provided an overview of DEN7961 Clinical Exam 1, the Professionalism stream of courses and a new course entitled, Essentials for Clinical Practice in Semester 5. The committee supported separating the clinical administrative portions of the professionalism stream of courses and the activities in the proposed, Essentials for Clinical Practice Course.</p> <p>Dr. Soto provided an overview of changes to the Clinical Treatment Planning Courses (see Attachment Overview). The updates provide a cumulative progression of RVU's, through semester 6 through 11. In semester 6, students would assist their clinical associate in 2 D0150 codes and 2 treatment plan presentations. In semester 7, students would complete and present 2 routine or moderate treatment plans. In semester 8, students would meet in small groups and present a formative oral presentation. In semester 9, students would complete 2 operator units with their 3DN clinical associates and in semester 10/11, present their summative oral presentation, which is a competency assessment.</p>	<p>Next steps: Work with Gail to develop a complete syllabus for Curriculum Committee review. Work with Margeaux to create a pacing guide. Scheduling would provide consideration for student exams. A major goal would be for students to participate in clinics whenever they are not in classes.</p> <p>Motion: The committee conceptually supports the proposed Essentials for Clinical Practice Course. Dr. Dilbone will prepare the complete syllabus for the course.
