Quality, affordable care is provided by dental students under close supervision of experienced faculty in our general dental centers. We treat patients from 14 years of age & up.

Fees are generally 50 percent less than private practice. Before becoming a patient, an initial screening appointment will be done to ensure that your dental needs are compatible with students' educational needs.

Faculty supervise and evaluate each treatment step provided by student dentists, so treatment takes longer than in a typical dental office. If that works for you, and your dental needs meet our students' educational needs, this could be a great option. If your dental needs aren't suited for this educational environment, we will refer you to another care group where residents or faculty provide care.

Tooth extractions are performed for a fee that covers an exam, X-ray and one simple extraction. A limited number of patients are seen beginning at 7 a.m., Monday – Friday. Dental students treat patients under faculty supervision.
