Compliance measures-general infection control		
Handwashing sinks are supplied with liquid soap/hand sanitizer/paper towels		
Proper hand hygiene is observed and can be described when questioned		
Red bag is visible and easily accessible as appropriate		
Disinfectant spray/wipes in each operatory		
Food/drink/cosmetics not used in patient treatment areas		
Cardboard shipping boxes not used for storage of dental supplies		
Dental Materials refrigerator		
Clean /organized/no food or drink		
Clearly marked no food or drink		
Biomedical Waste Procedures		
Biomed waste containers clearly marked/separated		
Sharps containers present/not overfilled each operatory		
Biomed waste procedure posted/understood		
Cleaning and Disinfection Practices		
Operatory is properly set up for patient with appropriate barriers		
Operatory is broken down/cleaned/disinfected properly		
Spray-wipe-spray OR wipe-discard-wipe is used for disinfection		
Counters and sink areas are disinfected		
Observation Measures-operating surfaces and sterile kit management		
Instrument kit opened after patient is seated		
Surfaces are maintained in a clean and organized manner		
No cross-contamination noted		
Unit dosing is utilized for supplies and dental materials		
No storage of patient care/ porous items under sinks in operatories		
Observation Measures-PPE		
Gloves in all sizes are found in each area		
Protective eyewear and masks worn during patient treatment		
Disposable cover gowns are worn during patient treatment in operatories		
Patients are observed wearing eye protection		
Staff, students, and faculty observations and interviews		
Medication log is maintained		
Staff know how to locate SDS book/database		
PPE is removed when leaving the operatories		
Emergency phone numbers are posted on phone		
Personnel can locate: oxygen, emergency kit, & AED assigned to their area		
Personnel can describe procedure for occupational exposure		
Needlestick protocol is easily found in the area		
Eyewash station is checked and logged on a weekly basis		
Rectangular collimator is in place and being used		
Computer is locked when provider leaves the operatory
