The reasons to consider this include consistency for students, consistency in our migration from ECO to Canvas gradebooks, ability to leverage UF data analytics opportunities and UFCD’s new curriculum management software, AEFIS. Members of the committee expressed support for one or two (didactic/preclinical) ranges, a wider A range and maintain a minimum passing grade of C.</p> <p>G.
