Minutes	Minutes	The committee reviewed the Aug. 12, 2020 minutes. The election results were shared: Dr. Ribeiro-Chair Dr. Echeto-Vice Chair	Motion: Approve the August 12, 2020 minutes. (Echeto/Caudle) Approved.
Proposals	DEN8290: Topics in General Dentistry DEN5XXX: Introduction to Clinical Care	Dila Kaya presented a new elective course. Presenters (8-10) would be invited to speak about specific general dentistry topics (examples included posterior composites, lasers, private practice and AEGD experience, etc.) This one credit elective course would be open to 1DN-4DN students. There was a question regarding the applicability of the topics to the 1DN students. Dr. Migliorati suggested that patient communication be added as one of the topics. Dr. Dilbone asked if the Dr. Dawson series was confirmed and suggested the syllabus language be changed to <i>“it may include topics from the Dr. Dawson series.”</i> Dr. Ribeiro reviewed the syllabus to the new course, Introduction to Clinical Care. This course is designed to provide foundational information in clinical care for novice dental students. Areas of patient safety, risk	The committee approved the course in concept and requested the final speakers be confirmed and complete syllabus be approval by Dr. Dilbone as the Department Chair, prior to returning to the Curriculum Committee for a final vote.

	DEN6XXX: Essentials of Clinical Practice	<p>management, infection prevention, standardized clinical practices (including work zones), information security, and emergency preparedness are applied by students to prepare them for clinical person-centered care. This is a one credit course to be offered in Semester 1, beginning Fall 2021.</p> <p>Dr. Echeto reviewed the syllabus to the new course, Essentials in Clinical Practice. This course is designed to review, reinforce and prepare students for entry into the clinical patient care in the UFCD TEAMS Clinics. Essential foundational concepts and skills in dentistry will be reviewed. Clinic procedures and protocols including emergency preparedness, associate group dynamics, and patient assignment as they relate to patient management and care will also be emphasized in this course. (The content of this course was part of DEN7961: Clin Exam 1 until it was discontinued and migrated to DEN7016 temporarily.) Dr. Echeto reported that the pre-requisite courses in this syllabus includes that all students must successfully complete all prior courses to be enrolled. The intent of this one credit course is to be offered initially in Semester 5. Due to Orange/Blue scheduling in Spring 2021 this course could not be scheduled until early in Semester 6, Summer 2021. The committee can evaluate moving earlier as scheduling allows.</p>	<p>Motion: Approve new course, DEN5XXX: Introduction to Clinical Care.
