Direct, Client Technology Svcs., UFIT</li></ul>	Guest speaker provided information on the challenges & recommendations related to computer systems with obsolete operating systems. Windows 7 operating system, will no longer be supported. With 3 years of extended funded for the system, it will officially be obsolete on December 21, 2021. UFIT has mechanisms in place to help devices on campus that are running Windows 7 so the solution is to submit an IT ticket if your lab needs help once the operating system is gone. Windows 10 some version will no longer be supported. The committee was informed that the life cycles of Windows drivers for a PC is 5 or 6 years.
