# IMPACT OF THE CHANGES

- **RDS Preclinical & Clinical Courses**
  - No changes in the failing grades as 72 is the current threshold.
- **Proposal 1**
  - We increase the window for the “A” letter grade
- **Proposal 2**
  - We increase the window for the “A”, “B+” and “C+” grades.

# CLINICAL GRADING

- **Keep the 1-4 scale** in the clinical setting
  - Continue using the axiUm reports
- **Grade calculations** are done **outside** CANVAS – Excel
  - Final grade is calculated under the 1-4 scale
  - Final grade is converted into the 100% scale
- **The percentage grade is uploaded** into CANVAS
  - CANVAS gradebook is set up so that all columns are set at 0%
  - Final grade column is set as **100% for final letter grade calculation**
