Charge to the Students Affairs Committee 2021-2022:

- 1 Review and revise the constitution and bylaws as necessary to reflect the mission and membership of the Student Affairs Committee.**

Action: The Students Affairs Committee reviewed and revised the constitution and bylaws and judged necessary to remove the "President of the Dentistry College Council" as part/membership of this committee as this person/position no longer exists. The suggestion/request was sent to the Constitution Committee. **Completed.**

- 2 **Develop committee guidelines to work more closely with the new Director of Student Affairs to take an active role in identification and discussions on current issues concerning students and developing programs that enhance student life at UFCD.**
- 3 **Develop committee guidelines (such as initiating joint committee meetings) to work more closely with the Associate Dean for Faculty Affairs and the Faculty Development Committee. This joint initiative should be focused on developing strategies to promote professional, productive relationships between students and faculty and students and administration.**

Action: The Students Affairs Committee initiated a work group within the committee and identified the current issues concerning students and discussed and helped developing measures and programs to enhance student life at UFCD as described in minutes from meeting held on 04/21/2022. All these achievements would not be possible without the combined effort and support from Dr. Probert, Dr. Pereira, Dr. Dilbone and Dr. Gibson. **Completed.**

Suggested by the committee as issues to be considered:

- 1 **Clinical requirements adjustments due to the COVID-19 pandemic.**

Action: Concern from the students' perspective were brought to the OAA. Students with pending requirements for graduation were notified and worked with course directors to complete their requirements. **Completed.**

- 2 **Addition of non-discrimination policy in course syllabus and patient care environment;**

Action: Concern from the students' perspective were brought to the OAA and SAI. Non-discrimination regulation was added to all UFCD course syllabi. **Completed.**

- 3 **Water fountains in the clinical floors.**

- **Action:** Concern from the students' perspective were brought to the CAQA. Functioning water fountains on each floor in the clinics and in the simulation lab with a stock of water bottle refills and cups. **Completed.**
