

Responsibilities

- Responsibilities for the Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor will focus on learner-centered pre-doctoral level didactic and pre-clinical and clinical instruction in general dentistry.
- The candidate's responsibilities will include serving as a course director and participating in intramural faculty practice, as well as distinction in academic pursuits and service.

Minimum Qualifications

- DDS, DMD, or equivalent dental degree.
- Applicants should possess the skills and knowledge to provide clinical coverage in all aspects of general dentistry.
- Applicants should be organized, open-minded and dedicated to excellence in teaching students according to the guidelines set by the department.
- The Assistant/Associate Professor should be proficient with technology and the use of electronic health records, abreast of current evidence-based dentistry and possess excellent communication skills.

- Teaching and private practice experience are preferred.
