Esthetics for the Pediatric Patient:

It's More Than Beauty!

A number of conditions can lead to esthetically unpleasant dentitions like dental caries, discoloration, dental trauma, premature loss of teeth, misalignment, anomalies of shape (peg laterals), and anomalies of color (MIH, fluorosis). Traumatic dental injuries can also have significant negative functional, esthetic, and psychological effects on children.

Currently, many esthetic solutions are available to the clinician. Selecting the right option for the patient is the biggest challenge.

Course Objectives

- Formulate evidence-based treatment strategies to maximize tooth preservation and pulp vitality.
- Review esthetic treatment options for traumatic injuries to primary and young permanent teeth with appropriate clinical cases.
- Treatment solutions for the different types of dental anomalies: MIH, Fluorosis, Amelogenesis Imperfecta.
- Esthetic solutions for primary incisors: zirconia crowns, composite strip crowns, composite restorations, and bulk fill composites.
