Part Time Enrollment Policy**

**Policy Statement**

The University of Florida College of Dentistry reserves the right to consider enrollment of a resident on a part-time basis, if it is in the best interest of the institution, college, residency program and/or student. Consideration is based on the following:

1. A formal application to the program of interest, including all appropriate application support documentation.
2. The student/resident must begin and complete the program at the University of Florida College of Dentistry.
3. The educational experiences, including clinical and didactic responsibilities, are the same as those of enrolled full-time students, and in accordance to accreditation standards.
4. Total educational time spent on a part-time basis is the equivalent of educational time spent on a full-time basis, in accordance to specialty specific standards. For example, a student enrolled half-time in a 24- month program must complete 48 months part-time.
