RESPONSIBILITIES

- ► This faculty position additionally includes opportunities for academic pursuits and service, as well as opportunities for participation in the development of departmental research and/or other scholarly activities.
- ▶ Applicants should possess the skills and knowledge to provide clinical coverage in all aspects of general dentistry.
- ▶ As well as being a strong clinician, applicants should be organized, open minded, dedicated to excellence in teaching students according to the guidelines set by the department.
- ▶ The candidate should be proficient with technology and the use of electronic health records, abreast of current evidence-based dentistry and possess excellent communication skills.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

▶ DDS, DMD or equivalent degree.

PREFERRED OUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ Post-graduate training in operative dentistry from a CODA-accredited institution.
- ► Teaching experience that has prepared the candidate to be a course director in operative dentistry.
- Clinical practice experience.
