RESPONSIBILITIES

- ▶ Responsibilities for this position will center on DMD and radiology residency program didactic, pre-clinical and clinical teaching, clinical activities, radiology faculty practice and on departmental research and/or other scholarly activities.
- ▶ The successful candidate will also be expected to obtain an affiliate appointment in the UF College of Medicine's Department of Radiology with appropriate credentialing for hospital appointment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ DDS, DMD or equivalent degree.
- ▶ Advanced Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology training from a CODA-accredited program.
- ▶ Applicants are expected to be board-certified or board-eligible through the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ Teaching experience in both DMD and an advanced education radiology program.
- ▶ Clinical practice experience preferred.
