## RESPONSIBILITIES

- ▶ The clinical associate/full professor will serve as Program Director for the Advanced Education Program in Operative and Esthetic Dentistry.
- ▶ Responsibilities focus on advanced education (resident-level) didactic, pre-clinical and clinical instruction, participation in research/scholarly activity and intramural faculty practice.
- ▶ As Program Director, responsibilities include program administration, preparation of reports, resident scheduling and faculty assignment.
- ▶ The Program Director is also responsible for the development and implementation of the curriculum plan, ongoing evaluation of program content and outcomes assessment, faculty teaching and resident performance, evaluation of resident training and supervision.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ DDS, DMD or equivalent degree. Master's Degree and/or PhD in Biomaterials or Operative Dentistry.
- ▶ Previous teaching experience in Operative Dentistry at the advanced education level.
- ▶ Evidence of expertise in esthetic and digital dentistry.
- ▶ Previous clinical and private practice experience.

## PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ Previous experience as a Program Director for an Advanced Education Program in Operative Dentistry.
- ▶ Involvement in research/scholarly activities.
- ▶ Expertise and national/international recognition in the field of contemporary esthetic dentistry.
- ▶ Expertise in digital dentistry (3Shape, Sirona and Planmeca digital workflows).
- ▶ Expertise in esthetic full mouth reconstruction, which includes deep understanding of integration of operative dentistry with implants, periodontology, prosthodontics and interdisciplinary treatment planning.
