



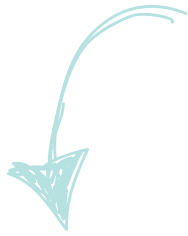

RESPONSIBILITIES

The clinical assistant/associate professor will be responsible for teaching within the Student Oral Surgery Clinic at the predoctoral/DMD level while excelling in academic pursuits, service, with some limited participation in the development of departmental research and/or other scholarly activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- DDS, DMD or equivalent degree required.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience with outpatient surgery including alveoloplasty, surgical extractions and medical management of patients is preferred.
- Florida Dental License preferred.
